New Fleet Map

The new VIP Fleet Map collects data from all sources connected to VIP, including AIS data from Oceanbolt, and displays the latest known vessel positions, including important contextual information such as cargos aboard and voyage status. Through new, enhanced filtering you can instantly get a bird's eye view of your fleet, monitor individual vessels and cargos, and make quick, data-backed decisions in the case of an operational emergency.
