SINGLE SIGN-ON



What it Is

Single Sign-On (SSO) enables any user to log on to the Veson IMOS Platform using existing organizational credentials. Instead of entering a unique username and password, users are verified by their organizational identity provider and seamlessly signed in to the Platform.

Why it Matters

Within modern organizations with growing complexity, it has become inefficient for users and administrators to manage unique sets of credentials for the numerous software tools within their corporate portfolio. SSO functionality streamlines usability and helps organizations better comply with security and IT policies.

With Single Sign-On, you can:

- Maintain the same user credentials and group membership for all supported business applications.
- Leverage existing authentication measures, such as password strength and multi-factor authentication policies.
- Manage user provisioning through one centralized directory.
- Improve employee access through a streamlined login process.

Security

Veson Nautical can interface with any SAML2-compliant identity service infrastructure for SSO user authentication. SSO user credentials and group membership are managed solely by the end user organization, and these credentials are never passed to or stored by Veson Nautical.
